Isaiah at a Glance

Book Theme	Salvation for Israel and the Nations through the Messianic King-Servant-Conqueror
Author	Isaiah
Recipients	Judah and Jerusalem
Date	740-680 bc
Message	The Messianic King will rule in righteousness over a righteous community, but he cannot do so until he becomes a Servant who provides righteousness for that community and a Conqueror who defeats the communities' enemies.
Historical Context	Uzziah, Jotham, Ahaz, and Hezekiah are kings of Judah. Contemporary prophets are Hosea and Micah. Israel is conquered and deported by Assyria in 722 bc. Judah narrowly avoids the same fate in 701 bc.

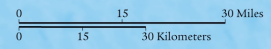

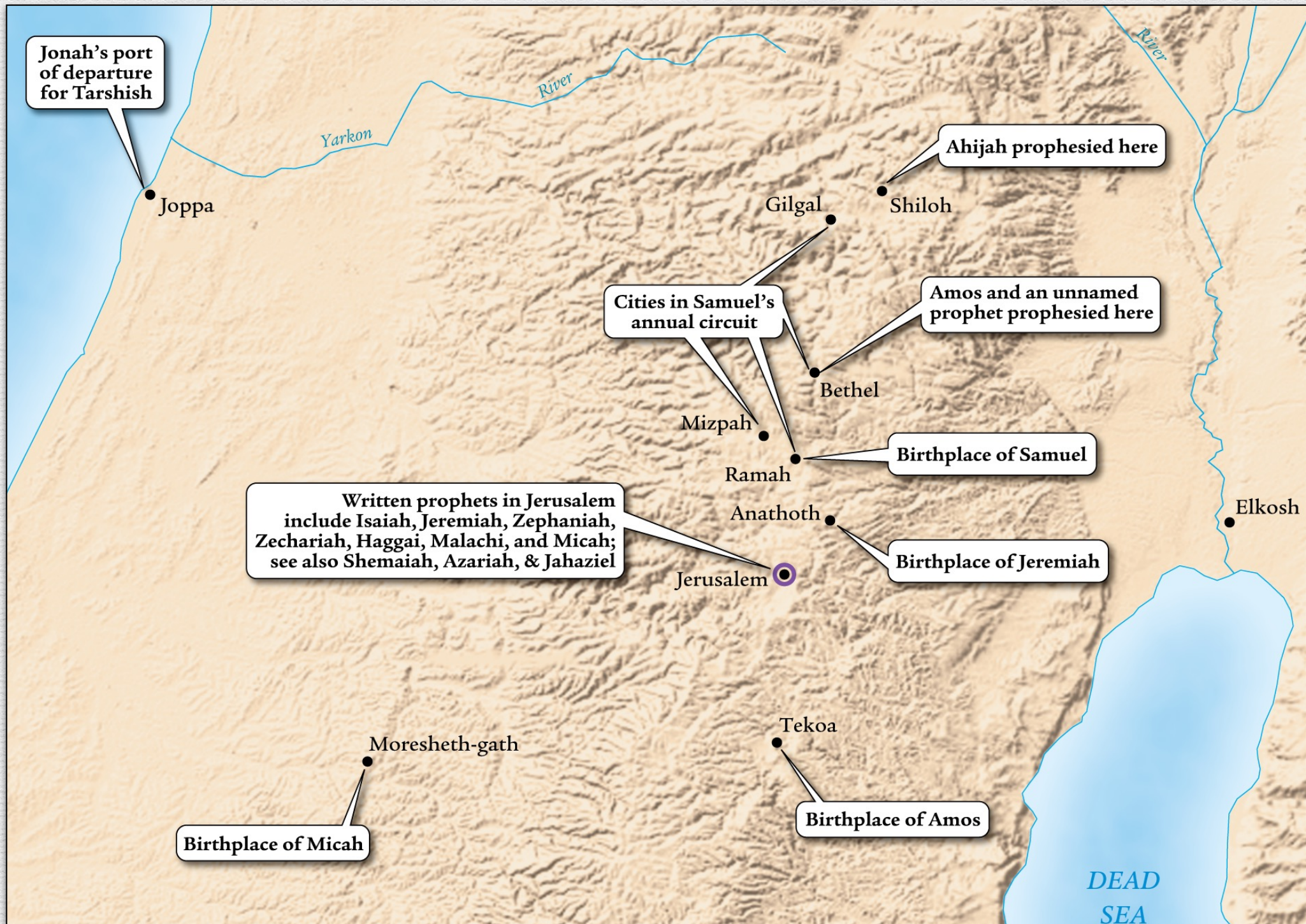


TRIBAL DISTRIBUTION OF PALESTINE
